

Section I. Strategy Overview

Public Relations Objectives

The Inland Empire/Desert Regional Consortium hired Interact Communications to develop long-term marketing and branding strategies to promote career education in the region. The core focus of the editorial calendar is to integrate the News Center, enewsletter, and organic social media posts to leverage key audiences for the greatest impact on career education. The content in this editorial calendar has been curated to circulate the appropriate messages, with the appropriate timing and choice of platform, to engage the college's target audiences and inspire action.

The goal of the editorial calendar is to:

- 1. Build positive perceptions about career education throughout the region.
- 2. Impact local stakeholders.
- 3. Provide IEDRC's community colleges with social media content around career education.
- 4. Reach IEDRC's career education target audiences.

The main public relations goals are to:

- 1. Lay out a strategy to guide the creation and implementation of organic (aka non-paid) social media activities.
- 2. Develop content that can be used on the IEDRC Ready campaign social media sites.
- 3. Raise awareness through the creation and distribution of engaging content about the learning and career advancement opportunities that exist in the Inland Empire/Desert region.
- 4. Position Inland Empire/Desert community colleges as the premiere educational choice for general education, career education, and lifelong learning, in the region and beyond.

Target Audiences

- 1. **Non-Traditional:** Students 24 and older who are just beginning their professional careers, looking to advance in an established career, or interested in changing their career trajectory
- 2. **Parents and Influencers:** Parents of high school students and young adults, as well as those who influence the decisions of that population (high school counselors, extended families, etc.)
- 3. **General Public:** The general public, including members of the business community, local organizations, alumni, and those who influence older students (families, employers, etc.)
- 4. **Internal Audiences:** Administrators, staff, faculty, and current students

Desired Action

The main goal of these public relations activities is to increase positive perception of the Inland Empire/Desert community college career education programs among their multiple target audiences, increase buy-in and support for career education, and drive applications and subsequent enrollments. However, there are other benchmarks we can use to measure our success. The following action elements can be tracked throughout the life of the campaign:

- 1. Increased engagement with social media and the website by key audiences
- 2. Increased applications and/or enrollment growth
- 3. Engagement with business, labor, and industry professionals, in order to develop and maintain partnerships
- 4. Increased student, faculty, and staff awareness of local community college career education options

Section II. Communication Platforms

Communication Channels, Target Audience, and Message Frequency

News Articles

Interact will repurpose past written articles from the Ready campaign News Center for dissemination via the monthly e-newsletter and social media sites.

Social Media

Interact will post to the Ready campaign Facebook and Instagram page once a week using articles from the News Center, viewbook, and other career education collateral as outlined in the monthly scheduled posts below.

Email Marketing

Interact will repurpose past News Center stories in an electronic e-newsletter distributed by Interact to a list of key stakeholders. The e-newsletter will consist of three stories and a written introduction from Ashley Etchison, Director, Strong Workforce Strategic Communications & Marketing. This is an effective way to reach key audiences with these stories of interest.

Print Magazine

Interact will repurpose past News Center stories in a quarterly print magazine, to be distributed to local business and industry leaders and other stakeholders.

Section III. Deliverables

News Center/Newsletter

- Each month, three previously produced articles hosted on the Ready News Center will be curated and distributed via e-newsletter. These articles will also be featured on social media sites for added coverage.
- The News Center articles to be included each month in the e-newsletter are outlined in the calendar below.
- Assigned stories can be updated at any point during the year; however, the current contract stipulates that no new writing will be produced.

Produced Social Media Posts

- Interact will post one organic social media post per week to the Consortium's Facebook and Instagram accounts.
- Interact will use past collateral (photography, video, viewbook stats, brochures, and News Center articles) for social media posts.
- All written social media posts for the Consortium's Facebook and Instagram
 pages were created with consideration to organic social media best practices.
 This includes the optimal length for posts. According to
 MarketingProfs, Facebook posts that are under 40 characters get 86 percent
 higher engagement than posts with more characters.

Suggested Organic Social Media Posts

- Interact has listed two ideas for two separate career-education-related posts each week, starting in November 2019 through October 2020, for the IEDRC community colleges to post to their respective college social media sites.
- The suggested posts include hashtag recommendations so that community college content will show up in new user feeds.
- The post topics were recommended around national, state, and local events with timing recommendations to leverage organic momentum.

- Engage in the moment—use hashtags during live events
- Use your campus experts
 - A quote from faculty or administrator for a hot career education topic or industry
- What do you like?
 - Notice what other schools/companies/organizations are doing well and copy it
